## Facts about Germany International Students in Germany


Approx. 2.7 million students in Germany, around 12 % foreigners.





In Brief Master's degree at a state or state-recognised German university, and in exceptional cases to take a doctoral degree, and to obtain a university qualification (Master's/PhD) in Germany

Who Graduates with at least two years' professional experience

Duration 12 to 36 months

Value 750 \_ 1000 €/month + additional allowances

## Paths to a PhD Individual vs. structured PhD

### Individual PhD

### Structured PhD

- Individual research under supervision of supervisor
- Optional courses or other forms of teaching / learning
- Mostly informal admission and marginal formalisation

- Guidance by a team of supervisors / supervising committee
- Mandatory, fixed supporting curriculum (interdisciplinary)
- Defined application process
- Offered by research training groups / graduate schools



## Research grants – Doctoral programs in Germany

- In Brief Doctoral project (individual or structured programme) at a state-run or state- recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- Who Graduates, Doctoral candidates, Postdoctoral researchers
- **Duration** Up to 3 years
- Value 1,000 \_ 1,200 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X



## Research grants – One-year and short-term grants

- In Brief Research or training project at a state-run or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- Who Graduates, Doctoral candidates, Postdoctoral researchers
- **Duration** One-year grants: 7\_10 months Short-term grants: 1\_6 months
- Value 1,000\_1,200 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X



### **Research grants – Binationally supervised doctoral degrees**

  Doctoral degree at home university with
  integrated research phases in Germany
- Who Doctoral candidates
- **Duration** Up to 2 years
- Value Grant: 1,000 €/month + additional allowances
- **Deadline** August 201X

## **Group study visit**

- Financial support for academic information visits to Germany for groups of students
- Requirements:
  - Group of 10 to 15 students plus one accompanying faculty member
  - Trip for 7 to 12 days



- Visit should be organized entirely by the home institution
- Application: filed by a faculty member, including total budget, a detailed itinerary, specific information about relationship to the curriculum, application form

Deadlines: November 1 (for trips between March 1 and June 1 of the following year) February 1 (for trips between June 1 and September 1 of the same year) May 1 (for trips no earlier than September 1 of the same year)
