

The process of implementing the memoranda of understanding signed by Alzahra University with international universities:

Alzahra University has so far signed about 100 memoranda of understanding for scientific and research cooperation with foreign universities, the text of all of which (by specifying the password) can be seen by the esteemed officials of Alzahra University. Colleagues can submit proposals to subsidiary units to implement the execute the Memorandum of Understanding by identifying appropriate areas for initiating or developing cooperation. Obviously, all the proposed collaborations will be supported by the university within the framework of the signed memoranda of understanding. Notes on educational, research, and cultural cooperation agreements with reputable universities abroad usually include the following:

- Educational collaborations, virtual co-teaching
- Joint supervision and counseling for graduate students' dissertations
- Holding joint conferences and scientific meetings virtually
- Conducting joint research projects
- Establishment of joint postgraduate courses by presenting a joint degree
- Joint publications (book, magazine, joint article)
- Use of laboratory and specialized equipment and technology transfer
- Access to specialized university libraries

In order to implement the above, in the process of signing a memorandum of understanding with foreign universities, the following is done:

- Appointing a representative by both parties to follow up on cooperation cases by mentioning the name and contact number and e-mail address in the text of the Memorandum of Understanding
- Planning and holding virtual meetings of the officials of the two universities in order to review the fields of cooperation and present proposals and conduct the necessary negotiations in the field of advancing cooperation.
- Sending the text of the signed memorandum of understanding to the faculties and working groups of international cooperation of Alzahra University, and announcing the readiness to receive proposals for the implementation of the agreements
- Reviewing the received offers and making the necessary correspondence with the foreign partner university
- Corresponding and obtaining the necessary permits from the ministry to implement the cooperation
- Support and make the necessary coordination for educational cooperation with professors of partner universities and joint guidance and counseling of graduate students' dissertations in order to implement cooperation
- Holding specialized meetings with the participation of professors from partner universities and professors of Alzahra University in various specialized fields

- Signing cooperation agreements in the framework of the memorandum of understanding signed in coordination with the vice-Chancellery of Education and Higher Education, VC of Research and Technology, and VC of Students Affairs
- Carrying out the necessary measures and coordination to fulfill the items of the cooperation agreement and obtain the necessary permits
- Submitting a report on the execution of the Memorandum of Understanding to the Center for International Scientific Cooperation of the ministry.

Laying the groundwork for signing new memoranda of understanding

Faculties and other affiliated units of Alzahra University, if they have active communication and cooperation with reputable foreign universities and research institutes, can offer to sign a memorandum of understanding or conclude a cooperation agreement within the existing memorandum of understanding according to the scientific strengths of the partner university. Provide foreign. Concluding cooperation agreements within the framework of memorandums of understanding signed with reputable foreign universities, including virtual educational cooperation, joint guidance and counseling of student dissertations, conducting joint research projects, professor-student exchange, joint publications (book, journal, joint article), Holding joint conferences and scientific meetings virtually, joint master's degree programs, and holding joint doctoral courses.
